Genesis 3:22 - The man **has become** like one form us, knowing good and evil

הָאָדָם הָיָה כְּאֶחָד מִמֶּנּוּ לְדַעַת טוֹב וְרָע

1 Samuel 20:34 - And **he did not eat** in the second day of the month

וְלֹא-אָכַל בְּיוֹם-הַחֹדֶשׁ הַשֵּׁנִי

1 Kings 19:4 - And **he went** into the wilderness, a journey of a day

וְהוּא-הֵלֵךְ בַּמִּדְבָּר דֶּרֶךְ יוֹם

Psalm 47:9[Eng 47:8] - God **sits** upon his holy throne

אֱלֹהִים יֹשֵׁב עַל-כִּסֵּא קֹדְשׁוֹ

Exodus 16:25 - Eat it today because today is a **Sabbath** to Yahweh

אֲכַלְהוּ הַיּוֹם כִּי-שַׁבָּת הַיּוֹם לַיהוָה

1 Kings 2:12 - And Solomon **sat** upon the throne of David, his father

וּשְׁלֹמֹה יֹשֵׁב עַל-כִּסֵּא דָוִד אָבִיו

Genesis 10:11 - From that land **he went (out)** to Assyria

מִן-הָאָרֶץ הַהִוא יָצָא אַשּׁוּר

Ezekiel 33:16 - Justice and righteousness **he has done**, he will surely live

מִשְׁפָּט וּצְדָקָה עָשָׂה חַיּוֹ יְחִיָּה

Genesis 1:31 - And God saw all that he had made

וַיִּרְאֵהוּ אֱלֹהִים אֶת-כָּל-אֲשֶׁר עָשָׂה

1. This is from the verbal root רָאָה, the reason that a ו has been added and a ה has been taken away will be explained in chapters 16 and 17.
