Psalm 48:10 - Your right hand **is filled** with righteousness

צֶדֶק מְלֵאָה¹ יְמִינֶךָ

Isaiah 17:10 - And the rock of your refuge **you have not remembered**

וְצוּר מְעֻזָּךְ לֹא זָכַרְתָּ²

Job 28:23 - And **he knows** its place

וְהוּא יָדַע³ אֶת־מְקוֹמָהּ

Isaiah 59:8 - The way of peace **they do not know**

דֶּרֶךְ שָׁלוֹם לֹא יָדְעוּ

2 Samuel 19:21 - For your servant **knows** that I have sinned

כִּי יָדַע עַבְדְּךָ כִּי אָנִי חָטָאתִי⁴

Genesis 41:57 - Because the famine **was strong** in all the earth/land

כִּי־חֲזָק הָרָעַב בְּכָל־הָאָרֶץ

Exodus 32:32 - Please blot me out of the book which **you have written**

מִחַנֵּי נָא מִסֵּפֶרְךָ אֲשֶׁר כָּתַבְתָּ⁵

1. Qal Perfect 3fs from מלא. We know "hand" is the subject because the verb is inflected in the feminine, and "righteousness" is masculine.

2. Qal Perfect 2fs from זכר. Negation by the particle לא

3. Qal Perfect 3ms from ידע - Lexical form (pause and worship for a moment!)

4. Although not a vocabulary word in this chapter, notice the 1cs inflection on the verb חטא

5. Qal Perfect 2ms from כתב

2 Chronicles 34:21 - Our fathers **did not keep** the word of Yahweh

לֹא-שָׁמְרוּ⁶ אֲבוֹתֵינוּ אֶת-דְּבַר יְהוָה

Proverbs 3:13 - Happy is the man who (he) finds wisdom

אֲשֶׁר־יִמְצֵא חֵכְמָה

6. ך is the 3cp verb ending in the perfect conjugation; here added to the verbal root שמר
