

## Biblical Examples Chapter 19

Ex 7:16 וְאָמַרְתָּ אֵלָיו יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵי הָעִבְרִים שְׁלַחְנִי אֵלֶיךָ

And you will say to him, "The Lord God of the Hebrews has sent me to you."

Gen 17:5 וְלֹא־יִקְרָא עוֹד אֶת־שְׁמֶךָ אַבְרָם וְהָיָה שְׁמֶךָ אַבְרָהָם כִּי אֲבִי־הַמּוֹן גּוֹיִם נִתְּתִיךָ

Your name will no longer be called Abram, but your name will be Abraham, for I have made you the father of many nations.

Est 4:7 וַיִּגְדַּל־לוֹ מְרַדְּכַי אֵת כָּל־אֲשֶׁר קָרָהוּ

Mordecai told him everything that had happened to him.

Ex 4:28 וַיִּגְדַּר מֹשֶׁה לְאַהֲרֹן אֵת כָּל־דְּבָרֵי יְהוָה אֲשֶׁר שְׁלַחוּ

Moses told Aaron all the words of the Lord that he had sent him.

Gen 18:19 כִּי יִדְעֵתִיו לְמַעַן אֲשֶׁר יִצְוֶה אֶת־בָּנָיו וְאֶת־בֵּיתוֹ אַחֲרָיו וְשָׁמְרוּ דֶרֶךְ יְהוָה

For I have chosen him, so that he will command his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord.

Psa 31:18 יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵי אֲבוֹשָׁה כִּי קָרָאתִיךָ

I, the Lord, have called you in righteousness and I will take hold of your hand and watch over you. I will appoint you as a covenant people, as a light to the nations.

Ex 33:20      וַיֹּאמֶר לֹא תוּכַל לִרְאוֹת אֶת־פָּנַי כִּי לֹא־יִרְאֵנִי  
הָאָדָם וְחַי

He said, "You are not able to see my face because no man can see me and live."

Psa 17:6      אֲנִי־קָרָאתִיךָ כִּי־תַעֲנֵנִי אֵל הַט־אָזְנוֹךָ לִי שְׁמַע  
אִמְרָתִי

I have called upon you for you will answer me, O God. Bend your ear to me; hear my speech.

Isa 41:9      עַבְדֵי־אַתָּה בְּחַרְתִּיךָ וְלֹא מֵאֲסִתִּיךָ

You are my servant. I have chosen you and not rejected you.

Hosea 8:7      קָמָה אֵין־לוֹ צֶמַח בְּלִי יַעֲשֶׂה־קֶמַח אוֹלֵי יַעֲשֶׂה  
זָרִים יִבְלַעְהוּ

The standing-grain has no growth. It will make no flour. If it happened to yield, strangers would swallow it up.

Psalm 5:5      כִּי לֹא אֵל־חַפְּזֵן רָשָׁע אַתָּה לֹא יִגְרֶךָ רָע

For you are not a God delighting in wickedness; evil does not dwell with you.

Prov 20:5 מִיָּם עֲמֻקִּים יֵעָצֵה בְּלֵב-אִישׁ וְאִישׁ תְּבוּנָה יִדְלֹגָהּ
