

Biblical Examples

Chapter 20

Num 20:21 וַיִּמָּאֵן אֲדֹם נָתַן אֶת־יִשְׂרָאֵל עֲבַר בְּגִבְלוֹ וַיֵּט
יִשְׂרָאֵל מֵעָלָיו

Edom refused to permit Israel to pass through his territory, so Israel turned away from him.

Jos 14:11 עוֹדָנִי הַיּוֹם חֲזָק כַּאֲשֶׁר בָּיוֹם שְׁלַח אוֹתִי מֹשֶׁה

I am still as strong today as the day Moses sent me.

Ex 2:15 וַיִּשְׁמַע פַּרְעֹה אֶת־הַדְּבָר הַזֶּה וַיִּבְקֹשׁ לְהָרֹג
אֶת־מֹשֶׁה וַיִּבְרַח מֹשֶׁה מִפְּנֵי פַרְעֹה

When Pharaoh heard this matter he sought to kill Moses, but Moses fled from Pharaoh.

Ruth 1:19 וַתֵּלֶכְנָה שְׁתֵּיהֶם עַד־בִּאָנָה בֵּית לָחֶם

And the two of them went on until they came to Bethlehem.

Gen 35:7 וַיִּבֶן שָׁם מִזְבֵּחַ וַיִּקְרָא לַמָּקוֹם אֵל בֵּית־אֵל
כִּי שָׁם נִגְלוּ אֵלָיו הָאֱלֹהִים בְּבִרְחוֹ מִפְּנֵי אָחִיו

And he built an altar there and he called the place El Bethel, for there God had revealed Himself to him when he was fleeing from his brother.

Deut 8:6 וּשְׁמַרְתָּ אֶת־מִצְוֹת יְהוָה אֱלֹהֶיךָ לִלְכֹת בְּדַרְכָּיו
וּלְיִרְאָה אֹתוֹ

You shall keep the commandments of the Lord
your God to walk in his ways and to fear Him.

Gen 11:5 וַיֵּרֶד יְהוָה לִרְאֹת אֶת־הָעִיר וְאֶת־הַמִּגְדָּל אֲשֶׁר
בָּנוּ בְנֵי הָאָדָם

The Lord came down to see the city and the
tower that the sons of men built.

Jos 5:12 וַיִּשְׁבֹּת הַמָּן מִמָּחֳרַת בְּאֲכָלָם מֵעֵבֹר הָאָרֶץ

The manna stopped the day after they ate from
the produce of the land.

1 Ki. 18:13 הֲלֹא־הִגַּד לְאֲדֹנָי אֵת אֲשֶׁר־עָשִׂיתִי בְּהָרֹג
אִיזָבֵל אֵת נְבִיאֵי יְהוָה

Was it not told to my lord what I did when
Jezebel was killing the prophets of the Lord.

Ex 3:4 וַיֵּרָא יְהוָה כִּי סָר לִרְאוֹת וַיִּקְרָא אֵלָיו אֱלֹהִים
מִתּוֹךְ הַסִּנֶּה וַיֹּאמֶר מֹשֶׁה מֹשֶׁה וַיֹּאמֶר הֲגִנִּי

When the Lord saw that he turned aside to look,
God called to him from the midst of the bush.
He said, "Moses! Moses!" And he said, "Here I
am."

Jos 6:8 וַיְהִי כַּאֲמֹר יְהוֹשֻׁעַ אֶל־הָעָם וּשְׁבַעַה הַכֹּהֲנִים
נָשְׂאִים שִׁבְעָה שׁוֹפְרוֹת הַיּוֹבְלִים לִפְנֵי יְהוָה עָבְרוּ וַתִּקְעוּ
בַּשּׁוֹפְרוֹת וַאֲרוֹן בְּרִית יְהוָה הָלַךְ אַחֲרֵיהֶם
When Joshua had spoken to the people, then
seven priests carrying seven rams' horns before
the Lord went ahead and blew the horns, and
the Ark of the Covenant of the Lord followed
after them.

1 Sam 9:13 כְּבֹאֲכֶם הָעִיר כֵּן תִּמְצְאוּן אֹתוֹ בְּטָרֶם יַעֲלֶה
הַבַּמָּתָה לֶאֱכֹל

When you enter the town, you will find him
before he goes up to the high place to eat.

Gen 32:7 וַיָּשָׁבוּ הַמַּלְאָכִים אֶל־יַעֲקֹב לֵאמֹר בָּאנוּ
[Eng 32:6] אֶל־אֶחָיִךְ אֶל־עֵשָׂו וְגַם הָלַךְ לִקְרֹאתָךְ
וְאַרְבַּע־מֵאוֹת אִישׁ עִמּוֹ

The messengers returned to Jacob, saying, "We
came to your brother, Esau, and he is even
coming to meet you, and 400 men are with
him."

Ecc 3:8 עֵת לְאַהֲבָה וְעֵת לְשִׂנְאָה עֵת מִלְחָמָה וְעֵת שְׁלוֹם

A time to love and a time to hate, a time for war
and a time for peace

Gen 28:20 וַיִּבֶר יַעֲקֹב נֶדֶר לֵאמֹר אִם־יְהִי אֱלֹהִים עִמָּדִי
וּשְׁמֵרָנִי בַדֶּרֶךְ הַזֶּה אֲשֶׁר אֲנֹכִי הוֹלֵךְ וְנָתַן־לִי לֶחֶם
לֶאֱכֹל וּבִגְדֵי לְבָשׁ

Jacob made a vow, saying, "If the Lord God
will be with me and watch over me on this
journey that I am taking, and gives me food to
eat and clothes to wear..."
