

Biblical Examples Chapter 35

Num 32:18 לֹא נָשׁוּב אֶל-בְּתִינוּ עַד הִתְנַחַל בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל
אִישׁ נַחֲלָתוֹ

We will not return to our homes until each Israelite has possessed his inheritance.

1 Sam 25:15 וְהָאֲנָשִׁים טָבִים לָנוּ מְאֹד וְלֹא הִכְלַמְנוּ
וְלֹא-פָקְדְנוּ מְאוּמָה כָּל-יְמֵי הַתְּהַלְכָנוּ אִתָּם בְּהִיוֹתֵנוּ בַשָּׂדֶה

Yet the men were very good to us, and we suffered no harm, and nothing was missing all the days that we went about with them, while we were in the field.

Is 65:16 אֲשֶׁר הִמְתַּבְרַךְ בָּאָרֶץ יִתְבָּרַךְ בֵּאלֹהֵי אֱמֶן

Whoever blesses himself in the land blesses himself by the God of truth.

Mic 1:4 וְנִמְסוּ הַהָרִים תַּחְתֵּי וְהָעִמְקִים יִתְבַּקְּעוּ כִּדְוֹנָג
מִפְּנֵי הָאֵשׁ כְּמִים מְגָרִים בְּמוֹרָד

The mountains melt beneath Him and the valleys break apart like wax before the fire,

Jer 46:7 מִי־זֶה כִּי־אָר יַעֲלֶה כִּנְהַרֹת יִתְגַּעְשׂוּ מִיָּמָיו

Who is this that rises like the Nile, like rivers of surging waters.

Prov 28:4 עֲזִבֵי תוֹרָה יִהְלְלוּ רָשָׁע וְשֹׁמְרֵי תוֹרָה יִתְגַּדְּרוּ בָם

Those who forsake the law praise the wicked,
but those who keep the law strive with them.

Samuel did not see Saul again until the day of his death, but Samuel mourned for Saul.

Jos 18:3 וַיֹּאמֶר יְהוֹשֻׁעַ אֶל־בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל עַד־אַנָּה אַתֶּם מְתַרְפְּיִים לְבוֹא לְרִשְׁתָּ אֶת־הָאָרֶץ אֲשֶׁר נָתַן לָכֶם יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵי אֲבוֹתֵיכֶם

Joshua said to the Israelites, "How long until will you do nothing to enter and possess the land which the Lord, the God of your fathers, has given you?"

2 Sam 12:19 וַיֵּרָא דָוִד כִּי עֲבָדָיו מְתַלְחָשִׁים וַיִּבֶן הָדָר כִּי מֵת הַיֶּלֶד

David saw that his servants were whispering among themselves, and David knew that the child was dead.

1 Chr 16:10 הִתְהַלְלוּ בְּשֵׁם קְדָשׁוֹ יִשְׂמַח לֵב מְבַקְשֵׁי יְהוָה

Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice.

Is 42:14 הַחֲשִׁיתִי מֵעוֹלָם אַחֲרִישׁ אֶת־אֲפָק

I have been silent for a long time; I have kept silent and restrained myself.

1 Ki 22:8 וַיֹּאמֶר מֶלֶךְ־יִשְׂרָאֵל אֶל־יְהוֹשָׁפָט עוֹד אִישׁ־אֶחָד
לְדָרֵשׁ אֶת־יְהוָה מֵאַתּוֹ וְאֲנִי שֹׂנְאֹתִיו כִּי לֹא־יִתְנַבֵּא
עָלַי טוֹב כִּי אֶסְרָע מִיִּכְיָהוּ בֶן־יִמְלָה וַיֹּאמֶר יְהוֹשָׁפָט
אֶל־יֹאמֵר הַמֶּלֶךְ כֵּן
