What are some translation values for Time other than "behold"?

Here are a few examples of translations for กินัก in the NIV:

הָנֶּה־אִישׁ צֶמַח שְׁמוֹ	Here is the man whose name is the Branch (Zech 6:12)

ה <u>נ</u> ה יְהוָה רֹכֵב עַל־עָב קַל	See, the Lord rides on a swift cloud (Is 19:1)
כִּי־ <u>הָנֵּה</u> יְהוְה יֹצֵא מִמְּקוֹמוֹ	Look! The Lord is coming from his dwelling place (Mic 1:3)
הְגָּה הַיּוֹם	The day is here! (Ezk 7:10)
הְנָּה עַם בָּא מִצְּפוֹן	Look! An army is coming from the north (Jer 50:41)
