### What are some translation values for הִנֵּה other than “behold”?

Here are a few examples of translations for הִנֵּה in the NIV:

הִנֵּה-אִישׁ צֶמַח שְׁמוֹ

**Here is** the man whose name is the Branch  
(Zech 6:12)

הִנֵּה שְׁלַחְתִּי הַגְּדִי הַזֶּה

**After all**, I did send her this young goat  
(Gen 38:23)

הִנֵּה דַם-הַבְּרִית

**This is** the blood of the covenant (Ex 24:8)

הִנֵּה-נָא דְבָרֵי הַנְּבִיאִים  
פֶּה-אֶחָד טוֹב אֶל-הַמֶּלֶךְ

**Look**, as one man the prophets are predicting  
success for the king (1 Ki 22:13)

הִנֵּה לֹא-יִנּוּם וְלֹא יִישָׁן  
שׁוֹמֵר יִשְׂרָאֵל

**Indeed**, he who watches over Israel will neither  
slumber nor sleep (Ps 121:4)

הִנֵּה אֵל יְשׁוּעָתִי

**Surely** God is my salvation (Is 12:2)

הִנֵּה יְהוָה רֹכֵב עַל-עַב  
קַל

**See**, the Lord rides on a swift cloud (Is 19:1)

כִּי-הִנֵּה יְהוָה יֵצֵא  
מִמְּקוֹמוֹ

**Look!** The Lord is coming from his dwelling place  
(Mic 1:3)

הִנֵּה הַיּוֹם

The day **is here!** (Ezk 7:10)

הִנֵּה עִם בָּא מִצָּפוֹן

**Look!** An army is coming from the north  
(Jer 50:41)

הִנֵּה בְּאֲמֹתַחְתִּי

**Here it is** in my sack (Gen 42:28)
