Why are the pronominal suffixes arrayed in the Grammar 1cs – 2ms – 2 fs instead of the way we learned verbs (3ms – 3fs – 2ms, etc.)?

When you first learned how to diagnose pronominal suffixes it was with nouns, prepositions and the definite direct object marker. That chart, in *BBH* § 9.16, pp. 93, was useful for working with non-verbal forms. The charts of Pronominal Suffixes on Verbs in § 19.2 and following were left in the format in which you originally learned them.
