Is there a shorthand way of practicing diagnostics?

Yes. Draw three rectangles like this □ □ □.
Each one of the rectangles represents one consonant of the tri-consonantal verbal root. Vowels can be drawn below, above and between the rectangles to represent the vocalization you want to practice.

For example, the Qal Infinitive Construct would be represented □ □ □[.]
and the Qal Infinitive Absolute would be □ ^ı □ □.

These rectangles will become very useful when you begin the Derived Stems in Chapter 24.
